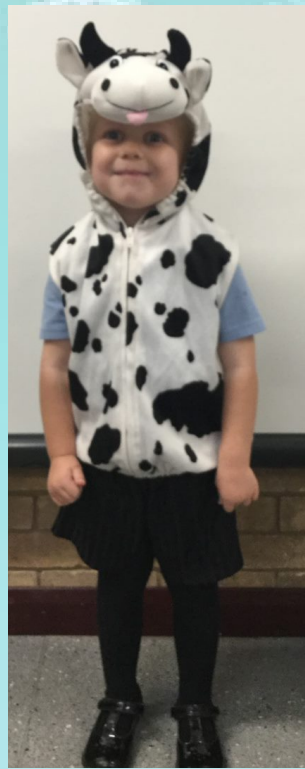

In KS2, pupils have designed and made Christmas hats. Pupils showed lots of creativity and looked fabulous in their new hats.



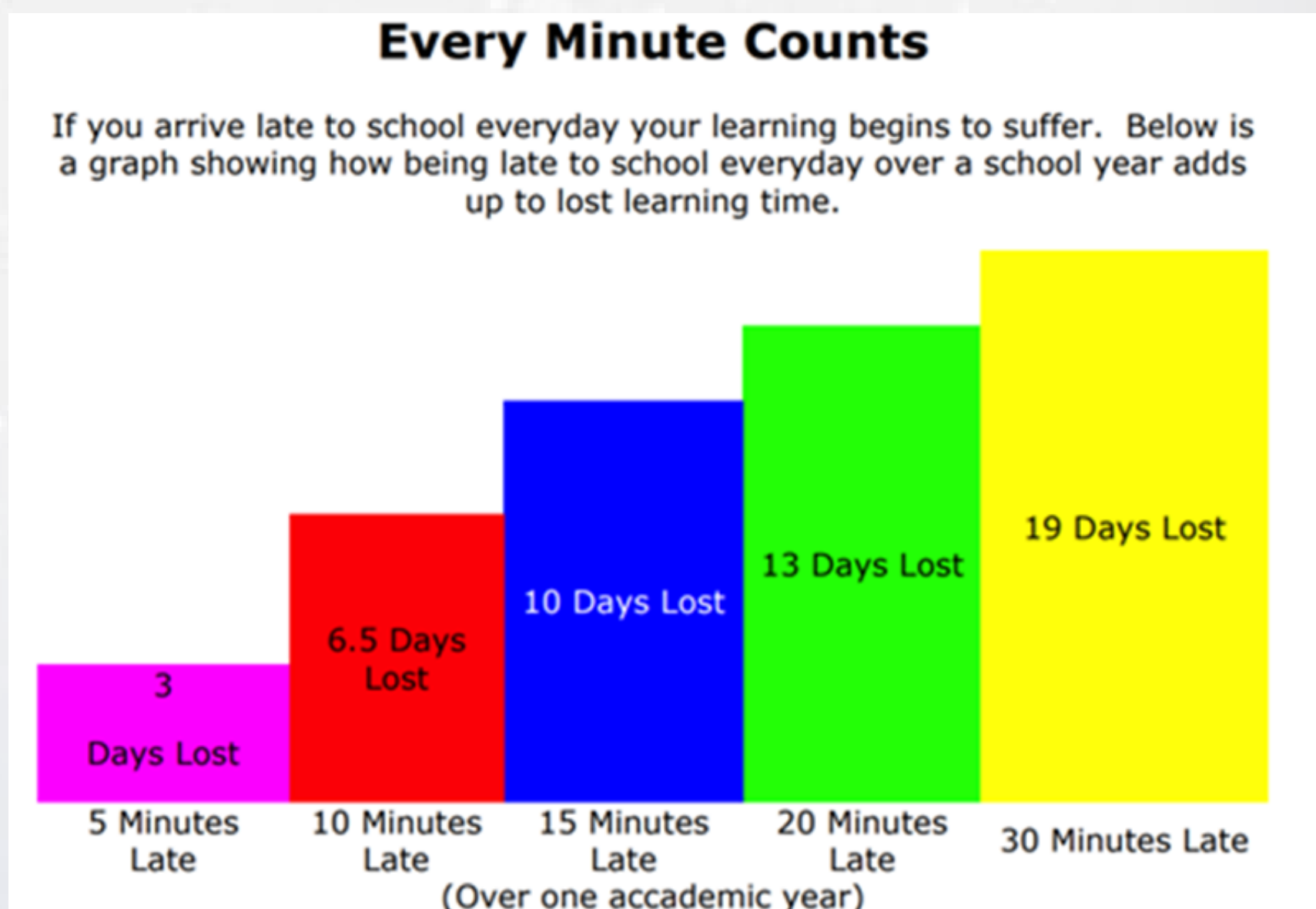

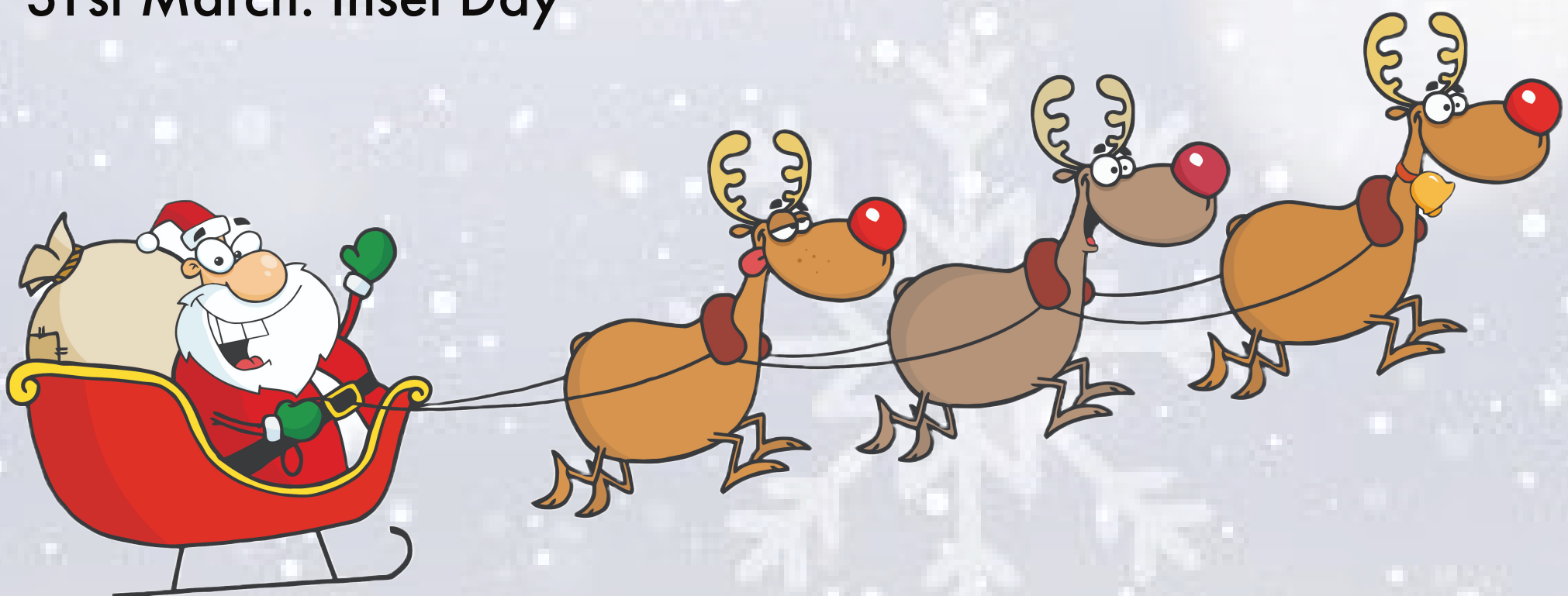
