Amen.


BLAS AR GYMRU! TASTE OF WALES!

This week, pupils at St David's have been engaged in all things Welsh! During the three days, pupils have had lots of different learning experiences where they have developed their understanding of Welsh language, culture, art, history, geography, food and lots more...

COLLABORATIVE ART / CELF GYDWEITHREDOL

In Art, pupils across the school have worked collaboratively to create pieces of a giant Ddraig Goch! Next this will be displayed proudly in our school entrance ready for our upcoming Eisteddfod.







WALES ON THE MAP / CYMRU AR Y MAP

In Humanities, pupils were developing their map reading skills and were locating different places in Wales.

Foundation Phase looked at where we are in Wales. We learned about where Flintshire is and explored some of the places we have in our county.

KS2 were using Google Earth to locate places in Wales and were then placing them on their own maps. We realised there are a lot of places in Wales!























As part of the rotation of activities, children explored the Forest School by matching natural objects with the corresponding adjective. The aim of the activity was to work in mixed age groups to find a range of items which meet each Welsh description. Older children helped the younger children with pronunciations when the groups shared their work. Once they had completed their first set, groups were then given a new set of cards to help them to explore further.














DIGITAL WELSH / CYMRAEG DIGIDOL

Pupils in KS2 read to Foundation Phase using props to help retell the story of Fflic a Fflac and they then went on to explore apps on the iPads.


Foundation Phase used the 'Betsan a Roco App' which included a series of games to help them develop their Welsh, Literacy and Numeracy.




