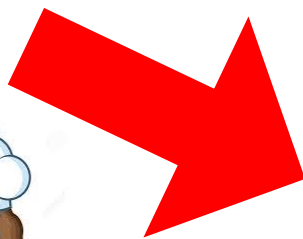
Cinema Night – Thursday, 24th October – Hotel Transylvania 3
