Today, we have supported Children in Need with an 'Own Clothes Day'. We have also enjoyed lots of Pudsey-themed activities in our classes!









#### **WILLIAM MORRIS**

As part of our Victorians topic, Year 5&6 have been exploring the work of William Morris. They have taken inspiration from his designs to recreate and print patterns.










#### FOREST SCHOOL


