SCHOOL UNIFORM

St. David's has a proud tradition in maintaining a school uniform to enable all our children to identify with the school and promote a sense of belonging. Uniform is available for purchase from Monkhouse in Mold. Please take a look at this key information for full details about our school uniform.

Nursery - Reception wear the following uniform:

- → maroon sweatshirt or cardigan
- → blue polo shirt
- → grey skirt, pinafore dress or trousers
- → black shoes (not trainers)
- → black or grey socks or tights

Years 1-6 are expected to wear the following uniform:

- → maroon school jumper or cardigan
- → blue shirt
- → school tie
- → grey skirt, pinafore dress or trousers
- → black shoes (not trainers)
- → black or grey socks or tights
- → school blazer (Year 3-6)





For PE, pupils must wear the following:

- → white t-shirt
- → black shorts, leggings or tracksuit bottoms
- → trainers

In cooler weather conditions, pupils are also permitted to wear a plain black jumper or hoodie.

Jewellery must not be worn for PE lessons.
