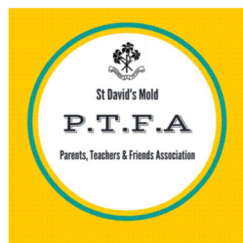

Nursery and Reception Dance Project

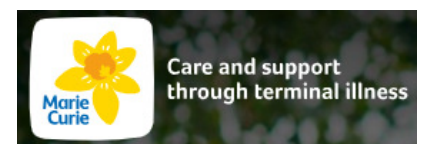
