If your child is unwell, then please keep them at home. We are living in strange and challenging times. If your child does display any symptoms, please let school know as soon as possible. If you do have a test, school requires the result as soon as possible regardless of the result.

COVID-19 Isolation Protocol

If we have a confirmed POSITIVE result in school, please note the following procedure: -

You will receive a SMS message via ParentMail to your phone requesting that you must collect your child immediately. It is essential that you have a plan in place for this possible event.

The children will need to self isolate for 10 days – following instruction from Environmental Health.

Under Track, Trace and Protect, your child's details will be shared with the Local Authority and Environmental Health.

We will advise you of all further action that will be required.



Safety Reminders

- ➔ 1 way system from the the car park still applies.
- ➔ Face Coverings to be worn on drop off and pick up by adults.
- ➔ Social Distancing - 2 Metres from other parents - no car sharing etc. No gathering in groups.
- ➔ No dogs on the school drive!
- ➔ No Parents or Visitors beyond the School Gate.
- ➔ As the spring bulbs are coming through on the grass around Fr Pius' house, could I respectfully ask parents to remind their children NOT to pick or run through the flowers/ play on the grass!

- grey skirt/pinafore dress or trousers (all years)
- powder blue polo shirt with maroon sweatshirt or sweat cardigan for Nursery and Reception;

- as for Years 1 and 2, plus school blazer for Years 3 to 6;
- in Summer, grey school shorts or blue checked dresses.
