

## Religious Education – Choices

Begin by reading, 'Tom and Jane'.

Ask your child:

- What do the words choice and consequence mean?
- What choices can you find in the story?
- What two choices did Mum give Paul?
- What do you think Paul said to his Mum?
- How do you think Jane felt when she heard what Tom said, and what Andrew said?
- How do you think Paul felt?
- What were the consequences of Paul's choice?
- What choices have you had to make recently, how did you choose and what were the consequences?

Activity suggestion:

Make a table with three columns. In the first column record choices made, in the second those which had good consequences and in the third those which had not so good consequences. Then discuss how more positive choices could be made in the future.
