Pentecost

Pentecost is an important feast day in the Church's calendar. We remember the coming of the Holy Spirit to the apostles, and celebrate the birthday of the Church.

Why not try out some of the projects below?

Creative writing:

If you are a keen writer, why not retell the story of Pentecost from the point of view of one of the people who were there? Think about how they might be feeling. You could illustrate your story, or even design a comic strip.

If you prefer non fiction writing, why not write a newspaper article about what happened during Pentecost.



Research project:

What can you find out about symbols of the Holy Spirit?

You could use the internet to research or any books you have available.

Why not design a poster with what you find out?

Or make a photo slideshow to show someone else in your family?

Reflection:

Choose a fruit of the Holy Spirit to reflect on and think about how you can live this out during the week.
