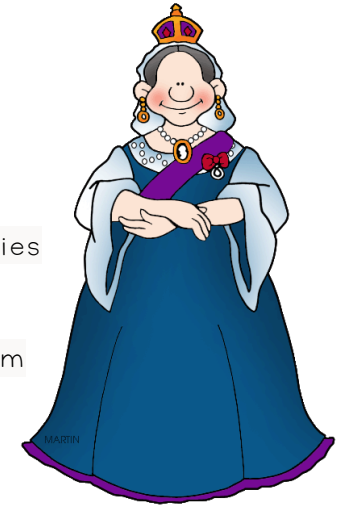


THE VICTORIANS
